HELLO and WELCOME to our **NEW** community newsletter, made possible by Trivallis with their generous grant funding .

This newsletter is an opportunity for us to communicate with you and allow you options to work with us on future projects. We are working with other organisations and are hopeful to revitalise much needed services for our area.

The Covid-19 Pandemic has taken it's toll on a lot of our prior projects and forced to re-evaluate the community and the needs going forward, we have delivered a successful food parcel and hot meals programme for the past year to those that needed it in our community, however, one of our aims prior to the pandemic was to work on combatting isolation and loneliness within the community, and this is now a bigger issue than previous with some of our regular clients still not comfortable in leaving their homes.

We are forward looking at looking at ways of bringing in new services to the

area. We are keen to work with the community and hear some of the ideas on making this work for everyone.









THE LISTENING PROJECT

MAKING A DIFFERENCE.....

The Listening Project operates from the Feel Good Factory in Ynysboeth, a beautifully converted church which houses a healthy living café and state of the art well equipped conference and activity rooms. The project works with older people in the community and is very much a befriending service based around volunteering opportunities, activities which the older people themselves identify as needed and wanted and the provision of hot meals and a food pantry.

Many older people are isolated and lonely, especially now covid lockdown is easing. Nina, the Listening Project Coordinator, is looking for volunteers who can spare a few hours a week to have a chat and be a caring and understanding presence in someone's life. In addition to befriending, there are lot of other volunteer opportunities.

All our volunteers will receive travel expenses, a lovely free lunch, training and will be part of a happy, friendly and caring team.

The Listening Project is already making a difference to the lives of our older people and you can help us make an even bigger and better difference.

PLACES CALLED HOME

The Listening Project volunteers are delighted to receive funding from "Places called Home" and thank the Big Lottery players and IKEA for their kindness and support. We now have a wonderful opportunity to develop our food pantry, a safe place where our older people can relax in comfortable surroundings, have a cup of tea, chat with each other, choose their own food rather than relying on having a food box delivered to their homes and generally encourage participation in other activities. The room will also double up as one in which our volunteers (many of them older people themselves) can manage for their own use for relaxation and training.

The Listening Project, based in the Feel Good Factory in Ynysboeth, is a befriending one. Working with a team of volunteers, we cook and hand deliver hot meals and food boxes to housebound older people in our community, building good supportive relationships. We are developing a programme of activities, which the older people have identified as what they would like, including bingo, tea parties, art classes, digital inclusion, fuel advice surgeries and lifelong learning classes.

Thank you so much "Places called Home" – Lottery players can be sure that their money is contributing to helping older people reintegrate into their community after a long period of loneliness and isolation during the covid pandemic.


